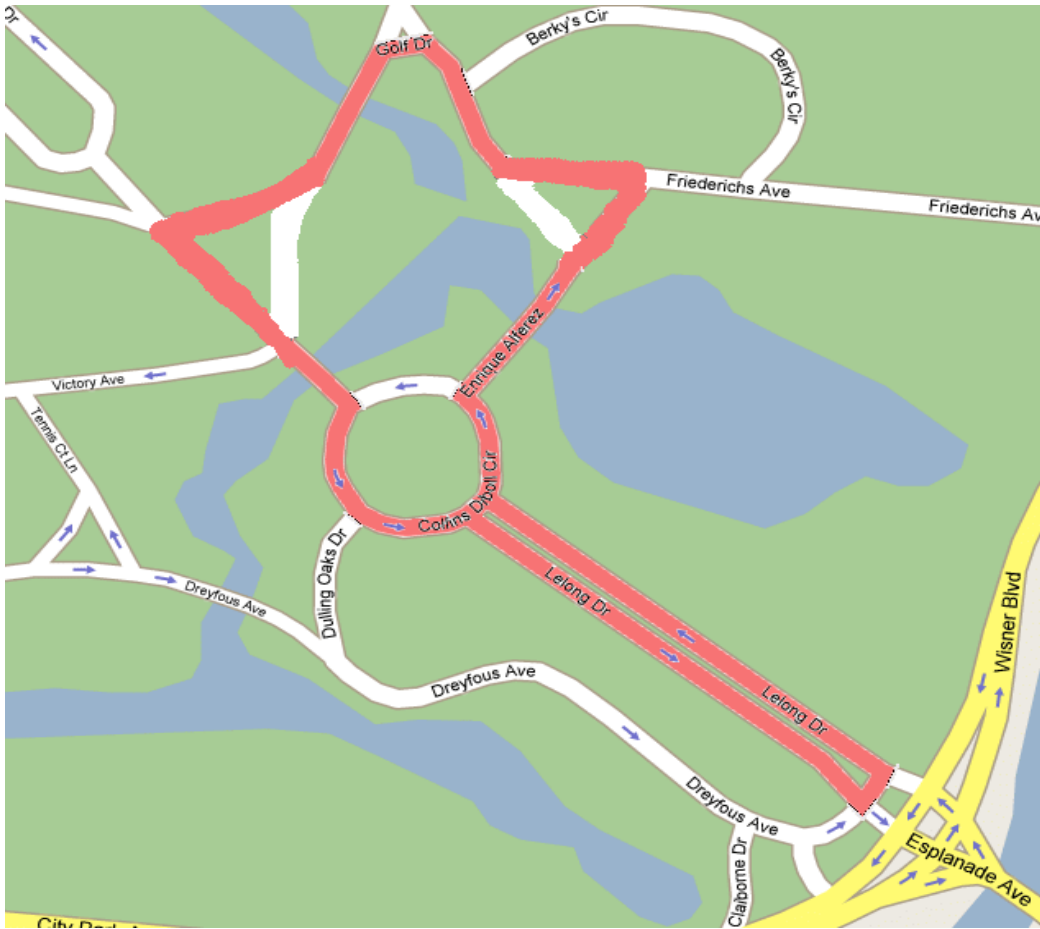


*State Championship Medals will be awarded to top finishers from La/Miss in each event. Non La/Miss riders are eligible for prizes and LCCS points but not state championship medals. Masters will race together for prize money but scored separately for state championship medals and LCCS points as well as women and juniors. Category 3 will be eligible for prizes but scored separately for state championships.



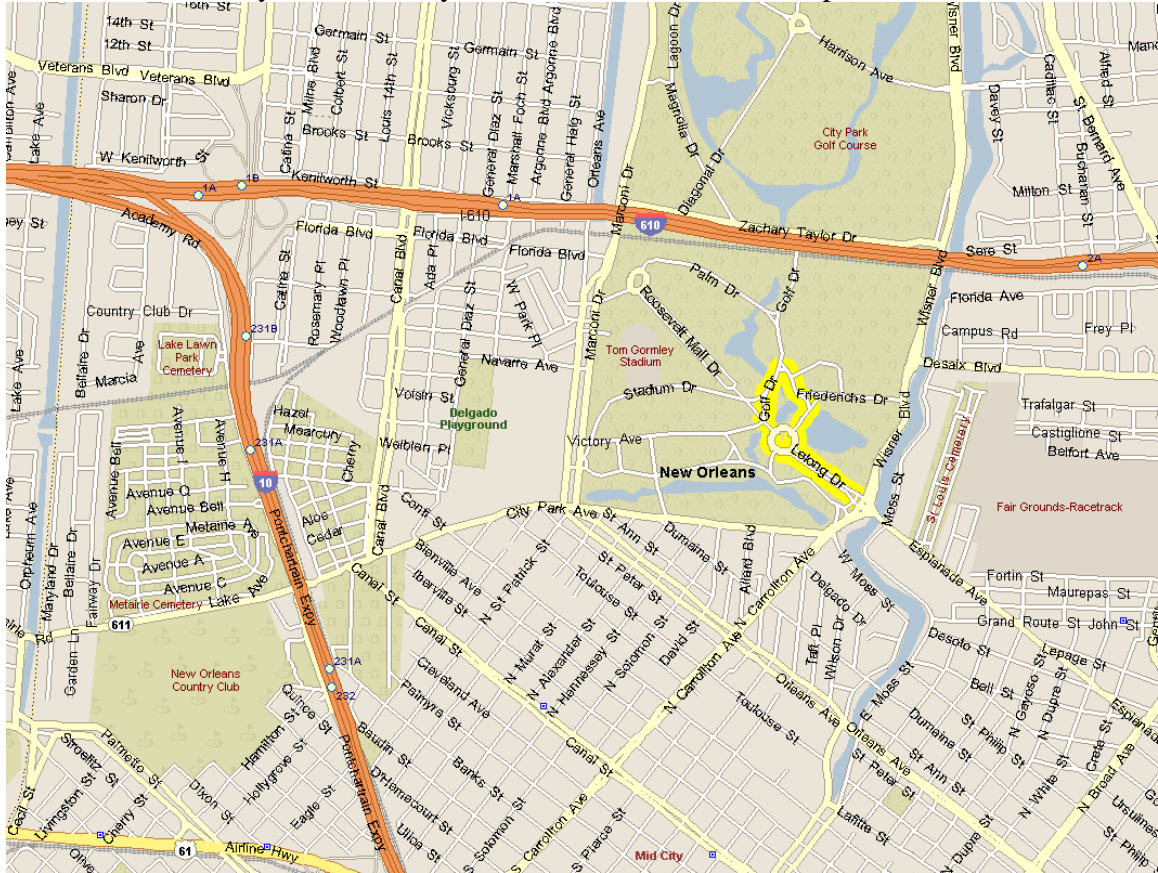
Course:

The course is 1 mile around the New Orleans Museum of Art in City Park on smooth asphalt.



Directions:

Traveling east into New Orleans on I-10, take the City Park Ave Exit. Take a left at the bottom of the ramp (driving under I-10) and follow City Park Avenue until the avenue ends at Wisner Blvd. Take a left on Wisner to Lelong Dr. Take a left on Lelong (you will see the museum on your left) and you will be directed where to park.



Registration:

Begins at 6:15 and ends 30 minutes before each event. Registration will be in front of the museum (Lelong Ave side).

Other Information:

- Promoter reserves the right to combine fields and adjust prize list, if minimum filed (10) is not met. Field limits of 100 racers, except Men 5 limited to 50 riders per USA cycling regulations.
- All USA Cycling rules are in effect. Racers must wear a helmet that satisfies the standards specified in USA Cycling Policies, securely fastened at all times.
- Race held rain or shine, no refunds. There is an area to warm up adjacent to the course or bring a trainer.

Net proceeds to benefit The Friends of City Park and the New Orleans Museum of Art in their rebuilding efforts.
