Race Information

- Course Description: Good, mostly flat roads around historic downtown Lake Charles. Approximately .85 miles with 4 turns and 1 loop right after the start/finish line.
- Online pre-registration* closes Friday night, April 29. One-day USCF licenses will be available on race day, or may be purchased online. USAC riders, please renew your racing licenses online prior to the race at usacycling.org.
- Race cost will be \$30 plus online registration fees. \$45 for race day registration. Register at www.usacycling.org
- Race day registration and packet pickup begins at 7am and closes 30 minutes before each race begins. Registration table will be located near the start finish line.
- Directions to the race: From I-10 take exit 29 towards downtown area. Follow signs for parking area.
- Parking: There is a parking area at the corner of Pujo St and Pithon St just south of the start/finish area.
- Race Hotel: Howard Johnson Inn 825 Broad Street Lake Charles, LA 70601 (337) 436-4311. Ask for race discount.
- District Championship Medals will be awarded to top finishers from La/Miss in each event. Non La/Miss riders are eligible for prizes and LCCS points but not state championship medals. Masters will race together for prize money but scored separately for district championship medals and LCCS points as well as women and juniors. Category 1,2 and Category 3 will be combined for prizes but scored separately for state championships.
- Promoter reserves the right to combine fields if minimum fieled (10) is not met. Field limits of 100 racers (Cat 1,2,3 and 4), 75 racers (Masters, Juniors and Women) and 50 racers (Cat 5) per USA cycling regulations.
- Promoter reserves the right to cancel/modify prize list per event if a minimum field of 20 participants is not met.
- All USA Cycling rules are in effect. Racers must wear a helmet that satisfies the standards specified in USA Cycling Policies, securely fastened at all times.
- USAC approved road bikes only.
- Race held rain or shine, no refunds.
- The surrounding streets are open to traffic so please be careful warming up on the roads. There will be a covered area near registration with plenty of room for trainers.
- One day rider license allowed but does not qualify for state championship medals.
